Frequently Asked Questions

Are we on our own to come and go as our schedule allows to view and discuss the art?

The hours the exhibition is available for viewing will vary at each Host Location. Call MJ at (701) 777-3599, to get connected with the correct host.

Will there be someone in attendance to talk to the students about the exhibition?

There will not be a designated NDMOA staff member at the Host Location. However, some Host Locations will have an onsite gallery attendant that may talk briefly about the exhibition. To assist you, we have lesson plans and activities available here on the website to help you prepare to view the exhibition.

What hours will the exhibition space be open?

Each Host Location may have different hours of operation. Contact MJ at (701) 777-3599, to get connected with the current host. Or contact the location directly.

What is the process for turning in bussing mileage and substitute teacher expenses?

At the Host Location, you will pick up a blank reimbursement form, an evaluation form, and a prepaid envelope. We ask that you fill out the forms and put them in the mail. Please contact the Museum at (701) 777-4195 to let us know you are sending them in so we can be on the lookout for your envelope.

Approximately, how long will it take to view the exhibition?

We suggest planning for 45 minutes to an hour.
